- The First SEC meet of AIIMS Bathinda was held on 30th June 2021 from 1200 hrs to 1330 hrs. The meeting was chaired by Shri Shwait Malik, Member of Parliament, Rajya Sabha, with the following members.

- At the outset, the Director AllMS Bathinda welcomed the Honorable Chairman and all other members to the SEC meet and discussed the achievements of AIIMS Bathinda in the last one year then he requested the Chairman to Chair the First SEC Meeting of AIIMS Bathinda.
- The Chairman called the meeting to order. It was noted that the quorum was complete. The Chairman requested the Member Secretary to introduce the agenda points and initiate discussion for threadbare deliberations.

AGENDA NO. 1.3 CONSIDERATION AND RECOMMENDATION CONSTRUCTION OF NIGHT SHELTER (DHARAMSHALA) BY NGOs/TRUSTS

- 4. Agenda. A donation offer had been received from Dwarka Dass Mittal Charitable Trust, Bathinda to construct a Patient Attendant Shelter Home at AIIMS Bathinda on joint management basis i.e., members from AIIMS Bathinda and Trust. For this a suitable piece of land measuring approximately 4000 sq.mtrs. is required. The proposal was submitted before the Standing Estate Committee for approval.
- Resolution. The Chairman, Standing Estate Committee in principle approved the agenda item with the following advice to AIIMS Bathinda: -
 - (a) The donor shall not have any claim in profit, income, or any asset. The land will not be transferred to the Trust.
 - (b) The Dharamshala should be operated by AIIMS Bathinda on no profit and no loss basis.
 - (c) There donor shall not be involved in any activity of the Dharamshala to prevent any ulterior or commercial objective.
 - (d) The Dharamshala Committee shall be Chaired either by the Director AIIMS Bathinda or his representative along with representative of Donor Trust. Or your Line
 - (e) The MoU shall be legally vetted and presented to the SEC members for approval.
 - (f) MoU of PGIMER Chandigarh may be used for reference and AIIMS Bathinda should consult AIIMS Bhopal for better functioning and preventing any future controversy.

AGENDA NO.1.4 CONSIDERATION & RECOMMENDATION OF OPENING OF BANKING FACILITIES IN THE CAMPUS OF AIIMS BATHINDA

- 6. Agenda. AllMS Bathinda projected the need of banking services at AllMS Campus for Patients, their attendants, Faculty, Staff, Students. Since AllMS Bathinda has started functioning and around 500 and above regular employees have joined the Institute and further faculty & non-faculty recruitment is in process. To facilitate the employees and for the smooth functioning of the institute, AllMS Bathinda stated the requirement of establishing a Banking Facilitation Centre within the campus.
- 7. Resolution. The Chairman, Standing Estate Committee in principle approved the agenda item with the following advice to AIIMS Bathinda: -
 - (a) The Banker shall establish contemporary means of digital transactions.
 - (b) Adequate ATMs shall be established by the bank for ease of operations.
 - (c) The MoU should explicitly mention the surface area allotted to the bank.

- The banker shall not have any rights over the roof utility of the said premises. (d) (e)
- The bank shall not the exclusive banker of AIIMS Bathinda.
- The MoU shall be legally vetted and presented to the SEC Members for (f) Approval.

AGENDA NO.1.5 CONSIDERATION & RECOMMENDATION FOR OPENING OF THE MILK BOOTH IN THE CAMPUS OF AIMS BATHINDA

- Agenda. In order to meet the day-to-day requirements of patients, their attendants, Faculty, Staff, Students, visitors, there is a need to establish a Milk Booth within the campus. AllMS Bathinda proposes to rent out a space measuring approx. 225 sq.ft duly identified by, a constituted committee for the said booth. The said site will be rented out through tendering process.
- Resolution. The Chairman, Standing Estate Committee in principle approved the agenda item with the following advice to AIIMS Bathinda: -
 - The Milk booth should be a temporary Kiosk.
 - Maximum lease period may be 5 years based on performance, review after completion of one year each time.
 - AllMS Bathinda should establish a food court in line with AllMS Delhi.

AGENDA NO.1.6 CONSIDERATION & RECOMMENDATION FOR ALLOTMENT OF WORKING NURSING HOSTEL ON THE BASIS OF HOSTEL RENT

- 10. Agenda. AllMS Bathinda has one Working Nurse Hostel, comprising of 150 single rooms, each measuring 09sqmtr. Since the Hostel accommodation for primarily meant for regular Nursing Staff/Students, House Rent Allowance is required to be deducted from their monthly salary. But as the single unit room at the Hostel accommodation is quite less in area, as compared to other residential accommodation at the campus, deduction of full month HRA may not be justified, considering the facilities offered at the Working Nurse Hostel. Due to this fact, most of the Nursing Staff have unofficially communicated their nonacceptance for the Hostel accommodation. We would also like to inform that their entitlement of housing is type-III in GPRA which should have the area of 44-65sqmtr. Though AllMS Bathinda has very less number of residential accommodation and nursing staff are in a large number. Particularly in these COVID times, it is essential for Nursing Staff to stay inside the campus. Also, in order to utilize the capacity of the Working Nurse Hostel, it is proposed that a monthly Rent, along with security deposit, fixed electricity & water charges may be fixed and charged from the allottees, instead of flat one-month HRA.
- Resolution. The Chairman, Standing Estate Committee advice that the matter be referred to Ministry of Health and Family Welfare for seeking guidance.

- 18. Agenda. The Director, AIIMS Bathinda expressed the need of future expansion of AIIMS Bathinda the requirement of additional land cannot be ruled out. And it was humbly submitted to the Chairman, Standing Estate Committee to look into the matter for the betterment of AIIMS Bathinda. Submitted for approval please.
- 19. Resolution. The Chairman, Standing Estate Committee approved the proposal and agreed with the concern. The Chairman assured that he would in person take up the matter with the Hon'ble Health Minister, MoHFW.

AGENDA NO. 1.11 CONISDERATION & RECOMMENDATION OF MOU BETWEEN AIMS BATHINDA & SBI

20. Agenda. In order to meet the patient's requirements of ATM services, AIIMS Bathinda has signed a MoU with SBI to Install ATM Machine in its OPD premises on 23 Dec 2019 having area 6.25 Sq. Mtr. at the monthly rent as per the guidelines of Housing and Urban Affairs, Directorate of Estates duly approved by Director AIIMS Bathinda. It is proposed that the SFC ratify the MoU between AIIMS Bathinda and SBI. The matter was also taken to the Institute Body & Standing Finance Committee Meetings, both the committee has passed the agenda. Salient features of MoU are as under.

AGENDA NO. 1.7 ALLOCATION OF RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION TO VARIOUS EMPLOYEES

- 12. Agenda. Vide Estate Branch circular No.AIMS/Bathinda/Estate/CIR-72 dated 09 April 2021, applications were invited for allotment of Type IV,III, and II residential Accommodations at AIMS Bathinda. The same has been allocated to the various employees of the AIIMS Bathinda. Submitted for information please.
- 13. Resolution. The Chairman, Standing Estate Committee approved the allotment.

AGENDA NO. 1.8 CONSIDERATION AND RECOMMENDATION OF GUEST HOUSE POLICY OF AIIMS BATHIDA

- 14. Agenda. The Guest House of AllMS Bathinda comprises of five single rooms, three double rooms, five deluxe rooms and two suite rooms. The Guest House is fully functional since 23 December 2019. The accommodation and food rates for the visitors have been fixed by Competent Authority AllMS Bathinda on No-Profit, No-Loss basis. The rates were presented before the Standing Estate Committee for approval and adoption.
- 15. Resolution. The Chairman, Standing Estate Committee approved the allotment.

AGENDA NO. 1.9 PERMISSION TO COMMENCE CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE-2 DWELLING UNITS AT AIMS BATHINDA TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF VARIOUS EMPLOYEES

- 16. Agenda. AllMS Bathinda is located at village Jodhpur Romana which is approx. 10 kms away from the main city and there is a paucity of accommodation in near proximity of AllMS Bathinda, due which the AllMS Bathinda employees are staying at faraway locations. Furthermore, due to increased housing demand, the rentals have increased in the region. Moreover, HRA of Class Z city is grossly inadequate to meet the rental requirements of the employees. Thus, the increased rents, far residences, increased commutation time adversely impacts the functioning of AllMS Bathinda. Hence there is an urgent requirement to commence the construction of additional dwelling units at AllMS Bathinda. Presently as per the ongoing project only 106 dwelling units have been incorporated in the construction work. Since, 506 regular employees have already joined AllMS Bathinda and we are in process of further Faculty & Non-Faculty recruitments, the above dwelling units are grossly inadequate to even accommodate the present sanctioned strength of AllMS Bathinda employees, vide which the additional dwelling units are urgently required, for which permission may be accorded.
- 17. Resolution. The Chairman, Standing Estate Committee agreed with the concern and assured that he would in person take up the matter with the Hon'ble Health Minister, MoHFW.

22. Agenda. As per MoHFW directions all new AIIMS were informed that AMRIT pharmacies to dispense all drugs, surgical disposables, implants and any other products, which are being prescribed and consumed by the Institute. In the same lines, the Mentor Institute had operationalized AMRIT Pharmacy at AIIMS Bathinda, accordingly AIIMS Bathinda has entered into an MoU with HLL AMRIT duly approved by Director AIIMS Bathinda. The pharmacy is successfully operating since 23 Dec 2019. It is proposed that the SFC ratify the MoU between AIIMS Bathinda and HLL AMRIT. The matter was also taken to the Institute Body & Standing Finance Committee Meetings; both the committee has passed the agenda. Salient features of MoU are as under.
