    3. Monitoring and Surveillance: Keeping a watchful eye on the campus to identify potential ragging incidents. This could involve assigning committee members to patrol the campus during the initial weeks of a new academic year.
    4. Immediate Response: Establishing a mechanism for students to report any incidents of ragging promptly. This could include setting up helpline numbers, email addresses, or physical drop-boxes for reporting.
    5. Investigation: Promptly investigate any reported ragging incidents to determine the facts and parties involved. The committee should ensure a fair and unbiased investigation.
    6. Counseling and Support: Providing necessary support and counseling to victims of ragging. This could involve offering psychological counseling and helping victims cope with the aftermath of such incidents.
    7. Disciplinary Actions: Recommending appropriate disciplinary actions against individuals or groups guilty of ragging. This might include suspension, expulsion, fines, or legal actions, depending on the severity of the incident.
    8. Regular Review: Continuously review and update the institution's anti-ragging policies and measures to ensure effectiveness.
    9. Coordination with Authorities: If necessary, collaborate with local law enforcement agencies to handle severe cases of ragging that might require legal intervention.
    10. Collaboration with Students: Encouraging students to actively participate in creating a ragging-free campus by promoting a sense of responsibility and community among them.
    11. Reporting to Higher Authorities: Providing regular reports to
