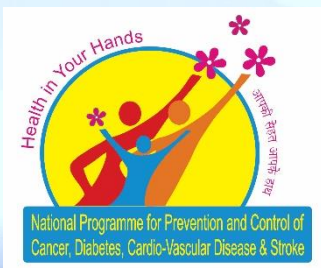

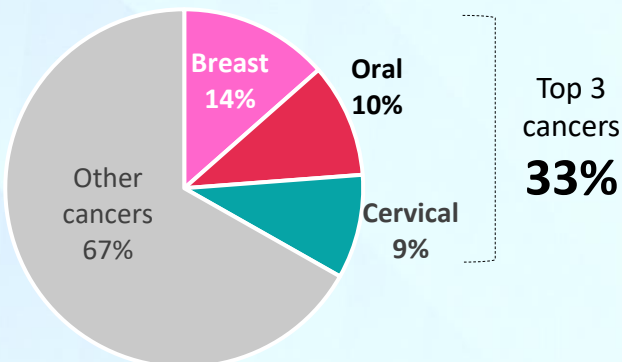
Cancer accounts for 8% of deaths in India each year. ~87% of cancers in India are detected late, which results in poor survival outcomes even if treated.

Cervical cancer is amongst the three most common cancers (oral, breast, and cervix) in India. Low awareness in community about the disease, and poor screening and treatment has led to late stage detection of the disease. Cervical cancer has the potential to be detected and treated early.

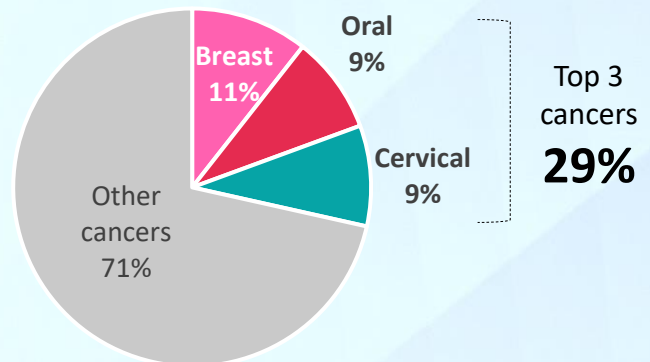
