Report on 2nd Day of Fire Safety Week Activities

The Second Day of Fire Safety Week at AIIMS Bathinda was conducted with great enthusiasm and active participation under the able guidance of our respected Director, Prof. (Dr.) Ratan Gupta.

The day was dedicated to strengthening fire safety awareness, emergency preparedness, and response capabilities across critical hospital and residential areas.

The details of the activities conducted are as follows:

Fire Safety Class and Mock Drill – Diagnostic Department

A fire safety awareness session along with a mock drill was conducted from **10:30 AM to 11:00 AM** in the Diagnostic Department.

The session included training on fire prevention techniques, use of fire extinguishers, and practical demonstration of PASS (Pull, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep) and RACE (Rescue, Alarm, Contain, Extinguish) methods for effective emergency response.

Fire Safety Audit – Critical Areas

A detailed Fire Safety Audit was conducted from **11:00 AM to 12:00 PM** in critical areas including SICU-1, SICU-2, and Emergency Department. The audit included inspection of fire safety equipment, systems, and preparedness in these high-risk zones.

Fire Safety Class and Mock Drill – OPD

From **12:00 PM to 12:30 PM**, a fire safety awareness session and mock drill was conducted in the OPD to enhance the preparedness of healthcare personnel in handling fire emergencies.

The training covered fire response techniques, including PASS and RACE methods, to ensure prompt and safe action during emergencies.

Fire Safety Webinar (MoHFW)

The Fire Safety Team attended a technical webinar organized by MoHFW from **02:00 PM to 04:00 PM**, focusing on fire safety measures in critical care areas such as ICU, NICU, PICU, and Operation Theatres.

Fire Safety Class and Mock Drill – Residential Quarters (Type 2 & Type 3)

A fire safety session and mock drill were conducted from **06:15 PM to 06:45 PM** in **Type 2 (T1, T2) and Type 3** residential quarters, covering awareness on fire hazards, evacuation procedures, and use of firefighting equipment.

Fire Safety Class and Mock Drill – Residential Quarters (Type 4 & Type 5)

Similar activities were conducted from **07:00 PM to 07:30 PM** in **Type 4 and Type 5** residential quarters, with emphasis on PASS and RACE methods, ensuring wider awareness and preparedness among residents.

The activities for the 2nd day were conducted smoothly and effectively, covering both hospital departments and residential areas. The initiative significantly contributed towards enhancing awareness, preparedness, and response capabilities related to fire safety among staff and residents.
