

Subject: Surgical Suturing & Knotting Workshop – (August 2026)

These supervised, hands-on, two days’ workshop was conducted on 19th & 20th August 2026 that aimed to impart surgical skills to medical undergraduate, interns & residents.

The objectives were to introduce the learners to essentials of surgical suturing and knotting required in open wound closure configurations and to provide practical opportunity for laparoscopic instrument handling, hand eye co-ordination with depth perception.

Utilizing the state-of-the-art Mobile Bus Training Lab provided by J&J, the workshop delivered high impact training in basic, open and laparoscopy suturing & knotting skills and advanced suturing techniques using endo-trainers & wet lab within an innovative, space-optimised environment.
