The Anesthesia team was led by Dr Ankita Dey (Assistant Professor). Surgery went successful, patient recovered well and got discharged in satisfactory general condition. This accomplishment comes on the heels of the team's previous achievement in performing a difficult nephrectomy in a high risk patient who had a nephroenteric fistula, an entity rarely seen in the medical field literature, further solidifying AIIMS Bathinda's position as a hub for advanced urological procedures.
