1. Designation - Project Consultant.

- To strengthen surveillance, prevention and control of zoonoses using one health approach to ensure operational continuity of the program.
- Should manage and organize training activities among the communities and institutes/ organizations.
- Coordination with other institution and cluster collaborator institution.
- Co-ordinate research/epidemiological investigations at the human-animal-ecosystem interface.
- Completion of any work assigned by PI and Co-PI in smooth functioning of program.
- Writing research articles for publication in reputed journals.
- Assist in development of trained health manpower by organizing training for core trainers and medical and paramedical professionals, monitoring training impact on the field and assessing emerging training needs.
- Doing a Mathematical model/Agent based modelling to study transmission of zoonotic pathogens in the community using data from humans, animals and non-point water pollution sources.
- Educating health professionals (human and veterinary) media, government officials and general public through teaching and training programs on zoonoses.
- Should work with the project team and liaison with stakeholders to organize the training.
- Liaison with other departments that have relevance to the program (Animal Husbandry, Veterinary etc.)
