Designation - Assistant Research Officer – 1 (UR)

1. **Programme & Surveillance Support** – Facilitate smooth implementation of programme activities and coordinate One Health surveillance across human, animal, and environmental health sectors.
2. **Data Management & Analysis** – Collect, manage, and analyse qualitative and quantitative data using relevant software (SPSS, R, STATA, Excel etc). Ensure data quality, develop dashboards/visualizations, and prepare evidence-based reports.
3. **Research Support** – Assist in research design, data collection, literature reviews, and preparation of manuscripts/reports.
4. **Documentation & Reporting** – Prepare technical reports, briefs, and presentations; contribute to progress updates and knowledge resources.
5. **Laboratory Support** – Coordinate with microbiologists and technicians for timely surveillance data, ensure accurate documentation, and support integration of lab findings into programme reports.
6. **IT & Digital Systems** – Strengthen digital tools for data entry, reporting, and visualization; support development of dashboards, GIS mapping, and mobile applications for programme monitoring.

2. All certificates to support the academic qualifications starting from bachelor's degree as applicable.
3. Work experience certificates.

6. Copies of research publications.
7. Two recent passport sized photographs one to be pasted on application form another to be pinned to the application form.
