## **Roles and Responsibilities of Staff: -**

### **Medical Officer**

- Administer primary clinical care encompassing diagnosis, treatment, minor operations, and emergency stabilization for all patients attending the MMU.
- Direct and oversee the MMU team, ensuring the synchronized operation of nurses, chemists, laboratory technicians, auxiliary nurse midwives, drivers, and support personnel.
- Execute national health initiatives (RMNCH+A, NCD screening, tuberculosis, vector-borne illness management, etc.) during outreach visits.
- Administer and supervise diagnostic services, analyses point-of-care testing, and facilitate prompt referrals for advanced care.
- Ensure precise documentation of patient data, registers, referral slips, and reporting via the HMIS/NCD portal.
- Guarantee the availability and effective management of pharmaceuticals and supplies, encompassing inventory oversight and emergency medications.
- Oversee the operation and upkeep of MMU apparatus including ECG, glucometer, blood pressure monitor, emergency pack, oxygen supply, and vehicle preparedness.
- Deliver health education and enhance community awareness by involving ASHAs, ANMs, and local leaders for efficient outreach.
- Guarantee the quality of care and patient safety, encompassing infection control, ethical practices, confidentiality, and appropriate biological waste disposal.
- Organize and supervise MMU operations, guaranteeing scheduled visits to designated sites, route optimization, collaboration with PHC personnel, and engagement in review meetings.

### **Paramedical Staff**

- Help the Medical Officer take care of patients by measuring vital signs, doing simple checks, and helping with first aid.
- Do diagnostic tests (RBS, Hb, pee tests, malaria and dengue rapid tests, etc.) and keep correct records of what happens in the lab.
- Give out medicines according to prescriptions and talk to patients about the dose, how to stick to the prescription, and side-effect precautions.
- Make sure that people in the MMU get registered, that people know how long they'll have to wait, and that patients' information is protected.
- Take care of your tools and materials by checking that diagnostic tools and first aid kits work and that things that can be used up are replaced.
- Give nursing care like giving IV or IM drugs, first aid, basic emergency care, injections, and treating wounds

- Support the start of national health programs like NCD screening, ANC/PNC tests, linking immunizations, and health education.
- Make sure that infection control and biomedical waste management are done by following the rules for safe disposal, cleaning, and cleanliness.
- Do things that reach out to the community, get people in the town to help, work with ASHAs/AWWs, and teach people about health.
- Keep records and reports, like patient files, lab logs, drug stock records, and help with the monthly MMU reports.

### **Liason Officer**

- Work with ASHAs, neighborhood leaders, and community groups to get people involved and make sure that as many people as possible are there for the MMU visits.
- Make a list of people and families who are fragile, such as the elderly, disabled, widows, members of marginalized groups, and others who need extra help or follow-up.
- Help with patient registration and guidance so that patients can understand their sickness, treatment, changes they need to make in their life, and the process of being referred to another provider.
- Give psychosocial help to people who have chronic illnesses, mental health problems, social issues, or stigma.
- You should help people learn about government health programs like Ayushman Bharat, JSY, TB rewards, and others. You should also help people get to primary, community, or district hospitals.
- Support the implementation of health awareness activities like IEC campaigns, group sessions, behavior change communication, and focused outreach.
- Do community assessments and field surveys to find disease trends and health needs, and to follow up with people at risk.
- Help keep track of people who fall behind on their treatments, like people who miss immunizations, stop TB treatment, or skip follow-ups for non-communicable diseases (NCDs). This will help make sure that they continue to get the care they need.
- Keep records and reports, like logs of therapy sessions, records of referrals, lists of community outreach activities, and case studies of social issues.
- Encourage connections between different sectors and work with local NGOs, panchayats, schools, and social welfare offices to deal with bigger social issues that affect people's health.

### **Staff Nurse**

- Help the Medical Officer with professional care tasks like measuring patients' vital signs, assessing patients, and doing first steps in triage.
- Give nurse care like first aid, wound dressing, injections (IV/IM/SC), nebulization, and basic emergency planning.

- Back health services for mothers and children. This includes ANC/PNC assessments, hemoglobin testing, advice on diet, and keeping an eye on growth.
- Help with NCD screening by measuring blood pressure, checking blood glucose, calculating BMI, and giving advice on how to change lifestyles.
- Get patients ready for tests, keep their information private, and make sure that patients move smoothly through the MMU.
- Keep track of and take care of medical supplies, like emergency drugs, consumables, dressings, and nursing tools.
- As the rules say, keep from getting infections and control them. This includes making sure that instruments are sterilized, surfaces are disinfected, and biomedical waste is thrown away separately.
- Take part in health education and outreach actions that support hygiene, nutrition, immunization, non- communicable disease, and communicable disease awareness campaigns.
- Record the nursing care that is given, update patient information, keep procedure logs, and help with data entry in the HMIS/NCD portal if that is needed.
- During emergencies, to help stabilize critical patients, and to plan transfers with the Medical Officer and community health workers.
- Make sure that nurse tools like the glucometer, nebulizer, thermometer, weighing scale, oxygen supplies, BP apparatus, and emergency kits are working correctly.
- You should work with ASHA/ANM and community workers to help get people to appointments and follow up with patients who are at high risk or vulnerable.
- Roll out Tele medicine unit and coordinating the same
