

PATTERN & SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

Name and Number of Posts	Medical Physicist (Radio Therapy) – 01 (UR) Medical Physicist (Nuclear Medicine) – 02 (01 – UR, 01 – SC)
Date of issue of Admit Card	08 January 2026 & 09 January 2026 Admit Cards may be collected from Examination Cell, AIIMS Bathinda on the above mentioned dates from 09:00 AM to 05:00 PM on 08 th January 2026 and before 10:00 AM on 09 th January 2026.
Date of Exam	09 January 2026 Timing: 11:00 AM to 02:00 PM Reporting Time: 10:00 AM - 10:30 AM (No student will be allowed entry after 10:30 AM)
Syllabus of Examination	Medical Physicist (Radio Therapy) The syllabus will be in accordance with education qualification and experience as mentioned in the Eligibility Section/Advertisement. Medical Physicist (Nuclear Medicine) The syllabus will be in accordance with education qualification and experience as mentioned in the Eligibility Section/Advertisement.
Scheme of Examination	Stage-I: Written test Stage-II: Screening for eligibility for qualified candidates based on uploaded certificates Stage-III: Interview test Stage I: Written test (a) There will be a set of 200 objective type questions. Each question will consist of 4 options with one single correct option. (b) Each correct response will get a score of 1 mark and wrong will be awarded 1/3 negative marking. Distribution of 200 objective questions. (a) 160 questions will be asked from post related subject as per educational qualification and experience mentioned in advertisement. (b) 40 questions will be from General English, Aptitude, Awareness. Stage II: Screening for eligibility for qualified candidates Stage III: Interview The Interview will carry 50 marks.
Duration & Medium of Examination	The Duration of Examination for Written test will be 3 hrs. (180 minutes). The medium of Written test and Interview will be English only.
Preparation of Merit & Resolution of Tie cases	Preparation of Merit: (a) The total number of candidates eligible to be called for the interview will be five (5) times the number of advertised seats advertised in the respective categories (UR/SC) based on merit in Stage-I. (b) The final merit list(s) for the categories i.e. UR/SC shall be prepared on the basis of combined marks obtained in Stage-I (Written Test) and Stage-III (Interview) of the candidates who appeared in both stages of selection process. (c) Candidature will be treated as cancelled for any candidate who have been called for Stage-III based on performance in Stage-I and remain absent in Stage-III (Interview). Resolution of Tie cases: In cases where more than one candidate secures equal marks, tie cases will be resolved. (a) First by using marks of written test (Stage-I) will be placed higher. (b) If not resolved by (a), the date of birth will be considered i.e. older in age will be placed above the younger.
