

GUIDELINES FOR RECRUITMENT EXAMINATION

- 1. Candidates must report to the examination centre well before the reporting time mentioned on the admit card. Late entry shall not be permitted under any circumstances.
- 2. Admit cards shall be issued by the Examination Cell. Candidates are required to collect their admit cards from the Examination Cell on 08^{th} January 2026 (from 09:00 AM to 05:00 PM) and 09^{th} January 2026 (from 08:00 AM to 10:00 AM).
- 3. Each candidate must carry one original and valid photo identity proof, such as:
 - (a) Aadhaar Card
 - (b) Driving Licence
 - (c) PAN Card
 - (d) Voter ID Card
- 4. Candidates are required to bring two (02) recent passport-size colour photographs to the examination centre for affixing on admit card and attendance sheet.
- 5. Candidates should bring their ball point pen (blue/black) for writing the examination. No stationery shall be provided at the examination centre.
- 6. The written examination shall be conducted on 09th January 2026 from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM . Candidates must be seated in the examination hall at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination. Reporting time shall be form 10:00 AM to 10:30 AM. No candidate shall be allowed to enter the examination centre after 10:30 AM.
- 7. Use of mobile phones, smart watches, calculators, Bluetooth devices, earphones, or any other electronic gadgets is strictly prohibited inside the examination hall.
- 8. Candidates are advised not to bring bags, books, notes, papers, or any valuable items to the examination centre. The institute shall not be responsible for safekeeping of personal belongings.
- 9. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given by the invigilators and those printed on the question paper/answer sheet.
- 10. Any form of unfair means, impersonation, or misconduct during the examination shall lead to immediate disqualification and further action as per applicable rules.
- 11. Candidates should occupy their seats as per the roll number and seating arrangement displayed at the examination centre.
- 12. Candidates will not be permitted to leave the examination hall before completion of the examination, except with prior permission of the invigilator.
- 13. Candidates must ensure that all required details are correctly filled in the answer sheet/question booklet as instructed.
- 14. Violation of any of the above guidelines may result in cancellation of candidature.
