### **\$Sponsored**

- Candidates who are permanent employees of any Central/State Government/Armed Forces or the Public Sector Undertaking/Autonomous Body can be sponsored by the respective Government/Defence Authorities or the Competent Authorities of PSU/Autonomous Body.
- A State Government can sponsor candidates only for those Fellowship Programme which are not available in the State. A certificate regarding non-availability of the Fellowship (for which the candidate is being sponsored) in the concerned State, duly signed by the Secretary/Director General of Health Services of the Central / State Government/ DGAFMS/Competent Authority or PSU/Autonomous Body viz. Director/Executive Head of the concerned organization, should be furnished in the format prescribed for this purpose.
- All eligible "sponsored" candidates will be called by the Institute for an entrance test.
- Seats as shown in the prospectus are available for "sponsored" candidates. Sponsored candidates will be designated as "Fellow".
- The subject for which the candidate is being sponsored should be clearly specified in the sponsorship form by the sponsoring authority. The candidate can be sponsored for only one subject. The applications of those candidates who are sponsored for more than one subject will not be considered.
- No "Sponsored" candidate will be paid any emoluments to the Institute during the training period. Such payments will be the responsibility of the sponsoring authority (i.e. Central/State Government or Defense Authorities).

### **Note:-**

- No constitutional reservation seats are available/applicable for any seats for any Fellowship courses.
- Number of seats advertised under Open & Sponsored group for various Fellowship in respective departments are not interchangeable/convertible between them as the application process is different.

*In accordance with Minimum Qualifications for Teachers in Medical Institutions (Amendment) Regulations, 2018 reproduced as under:*

*“4A. Determination of equivalence of the qualification of DNB (Broad Specialities) with MD/MS & DNB (Super-Specialities) with DM/M.Ch.*

(a) Those candidates who have undergone DNB training in an institution which now runs MCI recognized postgraduate degree courses in a given subject, their DNB qualifications shall be considered at par with MCI recognized qualifications in that subject only.

(b) Those candidates who have undergone DNB training in a multi-speciality teaching hospital with at least 500 beds, involved in various postgraduate/super-speciality teaching programmes provided that the one out of three DNB supervisors (teachers) qualify as postgraduate teacher as per MCI norms in his/her previous appointment; and one out of remaining two should qualify as postgraduate teacher as per MCI regulations with the following bed requirement for teaching unit:

Postgraduate Broad Specialities 30 beds per unit	}	50% beds should be teaching beds.
Postgraduate Super Specialities 20 beds per unit		

Such a qualification shall be considered at par with MCI recognized qualification.

(c) Those candidates who have three years teaching experience in the subject as Resident/Registrar/Demonstrator/ Tutor / or work experience gained during DNB training in both Broad Specialities and Super-Specialities course in other locations/institutions (100 or more bedded hospitals) shall work for one additional year as a senior resident in a MCI recognized/permitted institution for equivalence with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.

(d) Those candidates who have three years teaching experience in the subject as Resident/Registrar/Demonstrator/ Tutor / or work experience gained during DNB training or after possessing DNB qualification, in both Broad Specialities and SuperSpecialities course from an institution not covered in sub-clauses (a) to (c) shall work for two additional years as Sr. Resident/Research Associate (CSIR) in an MCI recognised/permitted medical college/institution for equivalence with MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.

(e) The candidates must have completed the requisite qualification, degree, and tenure by 28.02.2024. The candidates who are likely to complete their requisite qualification, degree, and tenure after 28.02.2024 will not be eligible to appear in this examination.

**Step-3** The offline filled application form with all relevant documents should be sent to the below mentioned address through Speed Post / Registered Post by **30 January 2026 till 5.00 PM IST.**

- Inadequately filled/ incomplete application form will be summarily rejected and no enquiry or representation will be entertained in this regard

**4. AGE-LIMIT :- No Upper Age Limit**

(In-service candidates will have to apply through the proper channels and submit a "**No Objection Certificate**" from their employer along with their application forms. All eligible candidates seeking admission (Including in service) will have to appear in the entrance examination and go through the process of selection as envisaged for all)

## **5. PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED FOR SELECTION FOR FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME:-**

Selections are made through 2-Stage Performance Evaluation basis:

- **Stage I:** Written test carrying **60 marks** of **60 minutes** duration in the subject wherein the candidate has applied for. The question paper will consist of **60 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)**.
  - **Stage II:** Out of the candidates who have secured **50% or more marks** in the written test (Stage-I), candidates **3 times the number of seats advertised will be called for departmental clinical/practical/lab-based assessment (carrying 40 marks)**.
- (a) *Candidate must secure 50% marks in Stage-I to qualify for Stage-II (Departmental Assessment).*
- (b) *Candidate must secure Overall more than 50% to become eligible for admission (Both Stage-I & Stage-II combined)*
- (c) *In case candidate gets >50% marks in Stage-I & <50% marks in Stage I & II combined, he will not be eligible for admission.*

**Final Selection:** Final result will be declared based on total marks obtained in **Stage-I** and **Stage-II Examination**.

**Note:** I) The result of **Stage-I** will be available on website of the Institute [www.aiimsbathinda.edu.in](http://www.aiimsbathinda.edu.in). No individual intimation will be communicated to candidates.  
II) Candidates who fail to attend any of the two stages mentioned above will not be eligible for admission. Selected candidates are required to join between **20<sup>th</sup> February 2026** to **28<sup>th</sup> February 2026**. The competent authority may permit an extension of joining till 15<sup>th</sup> March 2026 based on the merit of each case.  
III) Last date for admission the Fellowship Programme will be **31<sup>st</sup> March 2026**. In any circumstances, last date for admission will not be extended after **31<sup>st</sup> March 2026**.

## **6. PAY SCALE:**

**Pay Level – 11** of the Pay Matrix as per 7th CPC (Pre-Revised PB – 3), entry pay of **₹67,700/-** Per Month plus usual allowances plus NPA admissible under rules. NPA is applicable for Medical Candidates only. However, sponsored candidates are not entitled for any emoluments.

7. **COURSE FEES:** The selected candidate has to pay the following fees on the day of admission:

8. **BOND:** Candidates selected for Fellowship will execute a bond of **₹ 2,00,000/- (Two Lakh Rupees Only)** on a **Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of ₹ 100/-** along with **2 sureties**.

**9. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED IN ORIGINAL AT THE TIME OF INTERVIEW.**

On the day of Interview, the candidate is required to be present 'in person' with all original certificates **at Ground Floor, Admin Block, Medical College Building, AIIMS Bathinda before 09:00 AM** along with **one set of self-attested photocopies:**

- (a) Identity Proof (PAN Card, Passport, Driving License, Voter Card, Aadhar Card etc.)
- (b) Address Proof (Domicile Certificate, Ration Card, Passport etc.)
- (c) Certificate showing Date of Birth. (Birth Certificate/Matriculation Certificate)
- (d) Class 10th & 12th Marksheet and Certificates
- (e) MBBS marksheet and degree certificates
- (f) Attempt and Internship Certificate
- (g) FMGE certificate conducted by NBE (For foreign graduate)
- (h) Registration with Medical Council of India/State Medical Council
- (i) MD/DNB\*/MS/DM/M.Ch. Marksheet and degree certificates
- (j) Experience Certificate, if any
- (k) Candidates working in Government Institution- **No Objection Certificate**
- (l) Publications, if any
- (m) Any other relevant documents

**Note: Candidates who do not produce the above-mentioned original documents at the time of interview will not be considered for Admission.**

**TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. **Leave.** The leave entitlement of the appointee shall be governed by the Institute's leave rules as amended from time to time.
2. All original documents to be brought on the date of interview as mentioned in **para 9 above.**
3. The appointee shall not be entitled to any benefit like Provident Fund, Pension, Gratuity, Medical Attendance Treatment, Juniority, Promotion etc, or any other benefits available to the Government Servants, appointed on regular basis,
4. In case, any information given or declaration by the candidate is found to be false or if the candidate has wilfully suppressed any material information relevant to his/her admission, he/she will be liable to be removed from the Institute and any action taken as deemed fit by the competent authority.
5. The candidates are advised to visit the institutional website for any additional information and confirm about date and time / venue before coming for Exam/ Interview. No personal / by post information will be sent.

6. The period of experience, wherever prescribed, shall be counted after obtaining the prescribed qualification.
7. The prescribed qualification is minimum requirement and mere possessing the same does not entitle any candidate for admission.
8. You will have to conform to the rules of discipline and conduct of the Institute.
9. No travelling or other allowances will be paid to the candidate for attending the Exam /Interview
10. The candidate should not have been convicted by any Court of Law.
11. Canvassing in any form will render the candidate disqualified for the admission.
12. The decision of the Competent Authority regarding admission of the candidate will be final and no representations will be entertained in this regard. The decision of the committee shall be final and binding.
