Each question will carry 01 mark. b) There will be no negative marking. c) Result of Stage -I shortlist candidates will be declared (who have secured 50% or More marks) on the same day of Examination. (In stage -I result shortlisted Candidates will be 03 times of number of seats advertised in that particular branch)
Syllabus of Examination for stage-I	The Questions will be based on the General/Basic component and the applicable sub-specialty of the qualifying educational qualification as prescribed for the course for the which the examination is conducted.
Date & Time of Examination of Stage -II	11 th February 2026 at 10 :00 AM Onwards
Stage -II (departmental clinical/practical/lab-based assessment)	<u>Stage -II:</u> For those candidates who have secured 50% or more marks in the written test (Stage-I), candidates 3 times the number of seats advertised will be called for departmental clinical/practical/lab-based assessment (carrying 40 marks)
(a) Candidate must secure Overall more than 50% to become eligible for admission (Both in Stage-I & Stage-II combined)	
(b) In case candidate gets >50% marks in Stage-I & <50% marks in Stage I & II combined, he/she will not be eligible for admission	
Resolution of Tie Cases	In cases where more than one candidate secures equal marks in Stage -I, According to age (Date of birth), older candidates shall get preference over younger one.
