4. Administer and supervise diagnostic services, analyze point-of-care testing, and facilitate prompt referrals for advanced care.
5. Ensure precise documentation of patient data, registers, referral slips, and reporting via the HMIS/NCD portal.
6. Guarantee the availability and effective management of pharmaceuticals and supplies, encompassing inventory oversight and emergency medications.
7. Oversee the operation and upkeep of MMU apparatus including ECG, glucometer, blood pressure monitor, emergency pack, oxygen supply, and vehicle preparedness.
8. Deliver health education and enhance community awareness by involving ASHAs, ANMs, and local leaders for efficient outreach.
9. Guarantee the quality of care and patient safety, encompassing infection control, ethical practices, confidentiality, and appropriate biological waste disposal.
10. Organize and supervise MMU operations, guaranteeing scheduled visits to designated sites, route optimization, collaboration with PHC personnel, and engagement in review meetings.

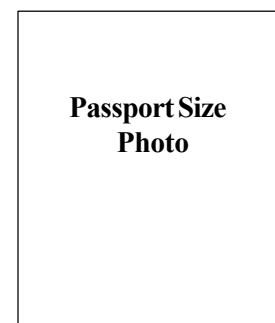
