



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLECTION OF ADMIT CARD (PHYSICAL MODE ONLY)

[For the post of Lecturer in Nursing (Assistant Professor) at AIIMS Bathinda]

Venue: Ground Floor, Medical College Building, AIIMS Bathinda

Date & Time: On 18 April 2026 between 09:00 AM and 05:00 PM and on 19 April 2026 between 08:00 AM and 10:00 AM (**Strictly**) for collection of admit card and biometric attendance.

All candidates are advised to carefully read the following instructions:

1. Collection of Admit Card: -

- Candidates must collect the Admit Card personally on the scheduled date and time. **Admit card will not be issued to any other person in any circumstances.**
- Admit Card will be issued only after verification of original identity proof.
- Candidates are advised to strictly follow the schedule. Late requests will not be entertained in any circumstances.
- No Admit Card will be sent by post/ email.

2. Documents required for collection of Admit Card: -

Candidates must bring the following documents:

- Two recent passport size colour photographs
- One Original Photo Identity Proof (any one):
 - Aadhaar Card
 - PAN Card
 - Driving License or any Govt. issued Photo ID card.
 - Voter ID Card
 - Passport
- Candidates must also bring one self-attested photocopy of ID proof to be submitted at the time of collection of Admit Card.

Note: Candidates without valid original photo ID proof will not be issued Admit Card.

3. Verification of details on Admit Card :-

Candidates must carefully check the following details immediately after receiving Admit Card:

In case of any discrepancy, candidates must inform Examination Cell immediately.

4. Important instructions regarding Admit Card:-

- Original Admit Card is a mandatory document for appearing in the examination.
- Entry into Examination Centre will not be permitted without Admit Card and valid original ID Proof.
- Admit Card must be produced on demand by the Invigilator at the Examination Centre.
- Candidates are advised to read all instructions mentioned on the Admit Card carefully.

5. Entry into Examination Centre:-

- i. Candidates must report at Examination Centre strictly as per reporting time mentioned in Admit Card and will not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall until the exam is over.
- ii. Late entry after closing time of entry will not be permitted in any circumstances (i.e after 01:30 PM).

6. Prohibited items inside Examination Centre: -

Candidates are strictly prohibited from carrying the following items:

*Pens will be provided during the Exam.

Possession of prohibited items in the Examination Hall may lead to cancellation of candidature and further action can be taken as per rules.

7. Dress Code: -


Candidates are advised to wear simple and appropriate dress. The following items are not permitted:

- Admit Card is issued provisionally subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions.
- Mere issue of Admit Card does not confer any right for appointment.
- Candidates must follow instructions issued by Examination Cell / Invigilators during examination.
- In case of any misconduct or use of unfair means, candidature will be cancelled and further action may be taken as per rules.
- No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the Written Test/ Interview.
- During conduct of exam, decision of Central Superintendent will be final and binding on all
- Candidates are instructed to look for setting plan before entry into examination centre.
