## **Roles and Responsibilities of Staff:**

### **I. Palliative Care Doctor 01 (One):**

#### **IPD –**

- To take ward rounds daily.
- Independently carry out a comprehensive patient assessment and develop a medical management plan.
- Present the ward round to a senior palliative care physician.
- Ensure that inputs of Specialist Palliative care physicians in the team are sought, taken, documented, and implemented for patient care plans.
- Maintain up-to-date and accurate documentation of care in patient records including electronic medical records.
- Independently carry out minor procedures at ward level like nasogastric tube insertion, urinary catheter insertion, wound management, etc.
- Keep up-to-date knowledge of the pharmacology of medications that are commonly used in palliative care.

#### **OPD –**

- Provide clinical care to patients referred through external OPDs.
- Triage the patients seen in external OPDs for OPD consultation or admission at day care or home care registration as per the need.

#### **Home Care Visit –**

- Visit patients at homecare as per the schedule and needs of the family/patient.

### **II. Palliative Care Nurse 03 (Three):**

- Conduct comprehensive assessment of patients' physical, emotional, and social needs.
- Provide management of symptoms such as pain, nausea, and breathlessness.
- Administer medications as prescribed and monitor for any side effects.
- Educate patients and their care givers on palliative care, symptom management, and self-care.
- Provide clinical care to patients in OPDs/IPD/Home care and discuss with senior palliative care physician and palliative care doctor.
- Plan and conduct home visits to provide palliative care services to patients as per the need of the patient.

- Maintain up-to-date record of patients visited during home visits.
- Collaborate with the multidisciplinary team, including doctors, social worker, and other healthcare professionals.
- Perform any other project-related duties assigned by the Principal Investigator/Project Lead.

### **III. Psychologist 01 (One):**

- Provide psychological assessment, counselling, and emotional support to patients and caregivers attending Palliative Care services.
- Provide OPD Services, IPD consultations and provide supportive care for admitted patients requiring psychological interventions.
- Conduct Home Care visits along with the multidisciplinary Palliative Care team for psychosocial assessment and counselling.
- Provide grief, bereavement, and caregiver support counselling to patients' families.
- Assist patients and caregivers in coping with stress, anxiety, depression, adjustment issues, and end-of-life concerns.
- Maintain proper documentation, counselling records, and patient follow-up details.
- Coordinate with doctors, nurses, social workers, and other team members for comprehensive patient care.
- Participate in awareness activities, training programs, and community outreach programs related to Palliative Care.
- Support implementation of psychosocial interventions and patient support activities under the project.
- Perform any other project-related duties assigned by the Principal Investigator/Project Lead

### **IV. Physiotherapist 01 (One)**

- Assess patients' functional status, mobility, pain, and rehabilitation needs.
- Provide physiotherapy interventions for pain relief, mobility improvement, positioning, breathing exercises, and prevention of complications.
- Assist patients in maintaining functional independence and improving quality of life.
- Provide physiotherapy services to patients in OPD, IPD, and Home Care settings as per patient needs.
- Educate patients and caregivers regarding exercises, mobility support, positioning, safe patient handling, and use of assistive devices.
- Maintain patient assessment, treatment, and follow-up records.
- Coordinate with the multidisciplinary palliative care team for comprehensive patient care.
- Participate in Home Care visits, awareness activities, rehabilitation planning, and community-based palliative care activities.
- Perform any other project-related duties assigned by the Principal Investigator/Project Lead.
