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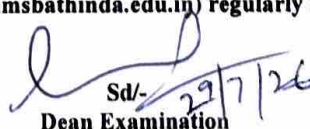

Please Bring Two Recent Passport size color Photograph & Valid ID Proof Such as Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Voter ID or Passport (Hardcopy In Original along with self-attested photocopy) on the exam day. Candidates without original photo Id will not be permitted to appear in the examination.

Reporting Time	07 August 2026 (10:00 AM to 10:30 AM)
Scheme of Examination	Stage I: a) The Question paper will be of 60 MCQs Based Questions carrying 60 marks of 60 minutes duration. Each question will carry 01 mark. b) There will be no negative marking. c) Result of Stage -I shortlisted candidates will be declared (who will secure 50% or More marks) on the same day of Examination. (In stage -I result shortlisted Candidates will be 03 times of number of seats advertised in that particular branch)
Syllabus of Examination for Stage-I	The Questions will be based on the General/Basic component and the applicable sub specialty of the qualifying educational qualification as prescribed for the course for the which the examination is conducted.
Date & Time of Examination of Stage -II	08 August 2026 at 09 :00 AM Onwards at Concerned department.
Stage -II (departmental clinical/practical/lab-based assessment)	Stage -II: For those candidates who have secured 50% or more marks in the written test (Stage-I), candidates 3 times the number of seats advertised will be called for departmental clinical/practical/lab-based assessment (carrying 40 marks)
(a) Candidate must secure Overall more than 50% to become eligible for admission (Both in Stage-I & Stage-II combined) (b) In case candidate gets >50% marks in Stage-I & <50% marks in Stage I & II combined, he/she will not be eligible for admission	
Resolution of Tie Cases	In cases where more than one candidate secures equal marks in Stage -I, according to age (Date of birth), older candidates shall get preference over younger one.
