The Institute invites applications from eligible Indian Nationals for engagement of the personnel purely on contractual basis under the **Addiction Treatment Facility (ATF)** established under the **National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR)**, supported by the **Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (MoSJE)**, **Government of India** and coordinated by the **National Drug Dependence Treatment Centre (NDDTC)**, **AIIMS, New Delhi**. The engagement shall **initially be for a period of one year or till continuation of the project, whichever is earlier**, and may be extended subject to satisfactory performance, availability of funds and continuation of the scheme.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: -

1. Age Limit:

Cutoff date to determine eligibility in terms of upper age limit and all other qualifications and experience of candidates will be the last date of submission of google form in the link mentioned in the application process i.e., **10 September 2026**.

- (i) The upper age limit is relaxable to 10 Years for Persons with Benchmark Disability.
- (ii) **To be eligible for selection** for these posts, the candidate should possess the essential qualification and experience on **10 September 2026** will be considered.
- (iii) The candidates who are in service in any Government Institutions are required to submit **No Objection Certificate** from the present employer at the time of Interview.
- (iv) No age relaxation will be available to reserved category candidates applying for unreserved vacancy.
- (v) Age relaxation will be regulated as per the instructions issued in this regard by Department of Personnel and Training from time to time.

Note: Candidates belonging to OBC/ SC/ ST category can apply for the aforementioned posts but they will not be eligible for any concession/relaxation etc.

No application fee is applicable for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) candidates. **The fee once remitted will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances.** Applications without the prescribed fee will not be considered and summarily rejected.

3. **Selection Procedure: -**

The selection will be on the basis of the interview. **The prescribed qualification is minimum requirement and mere possessing the same does not entitle any candidate for selection.** Candidates are requested to visit AIIMS, Bathinda website regularly for updates regarding recruitment/selection process.

4. **Tenure & Expiry of Contract: -**

The appointment is purely on contract basis initially for a period of **01 year or till continuation of the project, whichever is earlier. This appointment will not vest any right to claim by the candidate for regular appointment or permanent absorption in the Institute OR for continued contractual appointment, which may be renewed or terminated as per policy/rule/need of the Institute/terms of the project.** However, the contractual appointment shall not be extended beyond the period of one year and if the contract is not extended further, the same will lapse automatically. **The appointee can also leave the Institute by giving One months' notice or by paying salary in lieu of this notice period or for the period of which notice falls short of one month**

5. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- i. The appointment shall be purely on contractual basis under the Addiction Treatment Facility (ATF) established under the National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR) and funded by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (MoSJE), Government of India.
- ii. The selected candidate shall be governed by the rules and regulations of AIIMS Bathinda and by the terms and conditions of the ATF Scheme as amended from time to time.
- iii. The Competent Authority reserves the right to amend, modify or withdraw any condition of this advertisement without prior notice.
- iv. Candidates must ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions before submitting the application.
- v. If at any stage it is found that the candidate has furnished false information or suppressed any material fact, his/her candidature shall be cancelled and services, if appointed, shall be terminated without notice.

- Statutory deductions, wherever applicable, shall be made from the consolidated remuneration.

ii. Leave

- Leave shall be governed by the rules applicable to contractual/project employees of AIIMS Bathinda.
- Leave cannot be claimed as a matter of right.
- Unauthorized absence shall attract disciplinary action including termination of contract.

iii. Working Hours

The selected candidates shall work as per Institute working hours. However, they may be required to work beyond office hours, on holidays or weekends depending upon project requirements.

iv. Reporting Officer

The contractual staff shall report to the Nodal Officer/Principal Investigator, Addiction Treatment Facility (ATF), Department of Psychiatry, AIIMS Bathinda, or any other officer authorized by the Competent Authority.

v. Confidentiality

The selected candidates shall maintain complete confidentiality regarding patients, official records, research data and administrative matters during and after completion of the contractual engagement.

vi. Termination
