1. E-tenders in Two Bids (Technical & Financial) are invited on behalf of the Executive Director, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Bathinda, from interested and eligible manufacturers or their authorized distributors/dealers, for providing at **AIIMS Bathinda**.
2. Bids shall be submitted online only at CPPP website: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.
3. The complete bidding process is online. Bidders should be possession of valid digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for online submission of bids. Prior to bidding DSC need to be registered on the website mentioned above. For any assistance for e-bidding process, if required, bidder may contact to the helpdesk at **0164-2867830**.
4. Tenderer/Contractor/Bidders are advised to follow the instructions provided in the 'Instructions to the Contractors/Tenderer/Bidders for the e-submission of the bids online through the Central Public Procurement Portal for e Procurement at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>'.
5. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
6. Hard Copy of earnest money deposit and tender fee etc. must be delivered to AIIMS, Bathinda on or before last date/time of Bid Submission as mentioned above. The bid without EMD and tender fee will be summarily rejected.
7. The tender shall be submitted online in two part, viz., technical bid and financial bid. All the pages of bid being submitted must be signed and sequentially numbered by the bidder irrespective of nature of content of the documents before uploading.
The offers submitted by Telegram/Fax/email shall not be considered. No correspondence will be entertained in this matter.
8. Any future clarification and/or corrigendum(s) shall be communicated through <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> or through our website: www.aiimsbathinda.edu.in. The bidders are required to regularly check the website to know about any/all such corrigendum(s) as only these bids, taking care of such corrigendum(s) shall be considered for finalization of the tender.
9. Bidder should necessarily enclose a covering letter mentioning a summary of applied document with proper numbering. Secondly, bid should also attach a compliance sheet as per specification mentioning that they are complying to all specification or have any variation.
10. The pre bid conference would be held on as per tender document in the office of Tender Opening Room, AIIMS, Bathinda. All firm's representative who are attending the pre bid meeting, shall produce an authorization letter from their firm on the firm's letter head. They are required to put their query in writing before the committee and submit the same in writing on its letter head.
11. All the duly filled/completed pages of the tender should be given serial /page number on each page and signed by the owner of the firm or his Authorized signatory. In case the tenders are signed by the Authorized signatory, a copy of the power of attorney/authorization may be enclosed along with tender. A copy of the terms & conditions shall be signed on each page and submitted with the technical bid as token of acceptance of terms & conditions. Tender with unsigned pages/incomplete/partial/part of tender if submitted will be rejected outrightly.
12. Any omission in filling the columns of Financial Bid form (Schedule of Rates) shall debar a tender from being considered. Rates should be filled up carefully by the tenderer. All corrections in this schedule must be duly attested by full signature of the tenderers. The corrections made by using fluid and overwriting will not be accepted and tender would be rejected by full signature of the tenderers. The corrections made by using fluid and overwriting will not be accepted and tender would be rejected.
- 13.(i) **Bid Security:** -The bidder shall pay the respective amount of Bid Security (EMD) of Rs. 7,50, 000/ through SBI Collect Payment Gateway link on AIIMS Bathinda official website www.aiimsbathinda.edu.in or through this link - <https://www.onlinesbi.sbi/sbicollect/icollecthome.htm?corpID=2322756>. Or if the bidder is unable to submit the Bid Security (EMD) online, it may be submitted offline in the form of

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FDR/PBG/DD in the name of the Executive Director, AIIMS Bathinda.

- a. The Public Sector Undertaking of the Central/State Govt./MSEs/MSME/Registered with Central Purchase Organization are exempted from furnishing Earnest Money along with tender, **subject to submission of its valid proof.**
 - b. The firms Registered with DGS & D/SSI and any approved source of Centre/States Govt. are not exempted from furnishing Earnest Money in so far as this institute is concerned.
 - c. Earnest Money deposited with AIIMS, Bathinda in connection with any other tender enquiry even if for same/similar material / Stores by the tenderer will not be considered against this tender.
- (ii) EMD is required to protect the purchaser against the risk of Bidders conduct. The EMD will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends its tender or impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of its tender or if it comes to the notice that the information/ documents furnished in its tender is incorrect or false.
14. The bid security (EMD) without interest shall be returned to the unsuccessful bidders after finalization of contract with successful bidder.
15. Bidders are not allowed to submit more than one bid for the same/similar tendered item else all his bids shall be cancelled thereby making him disqualified in addition to the forfeiture of the EMD.
16. **Performance Bank Guarantee equals to 3% of the contract value** (calculated as per approximate value of the approved item). The Performance Security would be minimum Rs. 1,00,000.00 (Rupees ten lacs only) and maximum of Rs.10,00,000.00 (Rupees ten Lacs only). Those vendors who will be identified for the purpose of Rate Contract will be required to deposit the performance security within 21 days after accepting the Rate Contract and it should be valid for a period of 36 months from the date of issue of Rate Contract. **Performance Security should be submitted** in the form of FD/BG/TD/CD for **three months extra of the contract period** from any Nationalized/Schedule bank duly pledged in favor of "Executive Director AIIMS Bathinda" & payable at Bathinda only. The EMD deposited by successful bidder may be adjusted towards Security Deposit as demanded above after its validation for the required period. If the successful bidder fails to furnish the full security deposit or difference amount between Security Deposit and EMD within 21 (twenty-one) days after the issue of **Letter of Award** of Work, his bid security (EMD) shall be forfeited and award of tender in suppliers favor automatically stands terminated at his cost & liability, unless time extension has been granted by AIIMS, Bathinda.
17. The EMD/PBG shall be forfeited if successful bidder fails to supply the goods/equipment in stipulated time or fails to comply with any of the terms & conditions of the contract or fail to sign the contract.
18. The bid shall be valid and open for acceptance by the competent authority of AIIMS Bathinda for a period of 180 (one hundred eighty) days from the published date of opening of the tenders and no request for any variation in quoted rates and / withdrawal of tender on any ground by bidders shall be entertained. The unilateral withdraw at any stage will cause forfeiture of EMD in addition to any remedy that the purchaser may have under the law.
19. To assist in the analysis, evaluation and computation of the bids, the Competent Authority, may ask bidders individually for clarification of their bids. The request for Clarification and the response shall be in writing but no change in the price or substance of the bid offered shall be permitted.
20. After evaluation, the work shall be awarded normally to the Agency fulfilling all the conditions of the contract and who has quoted the lowest rate as per financial bid after complying with the all the Acts / provisions stated / referred to for adherence in the tender.
21. The competent authority of AIIMS, Bathinda reserves all rights to accept or reject any/ all tender(s) without assigning any reason. It can also impose/relax any administrative term and condition/specifications of the tender enquiry after due discussion in pre-bid conference. This will be communicated and shown over the website of the Institute. No representation will be considered after pre-bid meeting and **bidders may ensure its queries only in pre-bid meeting.** AIIMS, Bathinda also reserves the right to reject any bid which in his opinion is non- responsive or violating any of the conditions/specifications without any liability to any loss whatsoever it may cause to the bidder in the process.
22. Tender must be submitted on the prescribed Tender Form otherwise tender will be cancelled straightway.
23. The tender form is not transferable.
24. Canvassing in any form is strictly prohibited and the tenderers who are found canvassing are liable to have their tenders rejected out rightly.

25. It is required by all concerned, namely the Bidders/Suppliers, as the case may be to observe highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of this Tender.

26. Delivery at consignee's site (AIIMS Bathinda) should be free of cost immediately on arrival

27. In case the quality of goods supplied are not in conformity with the standard given in tender and as per the samples supplied or the supplies are found defective at any stage these goods shall immediately will be taken back by the supplier and will be replaced with the tender quality goods, without any delay. The competent authority reserves all rights to reject the goods if the same are not found in accordance with the required description / specifications and liquidates damages shall be charged in addition to the cost of re-tender. The supplier is required to provide the demonstration of equipment at AIIMS premises to the AIIMS representatives for its evaluation as per the specification & desired functionality standard. However, a submission of videography displaying functionality as per tender specification may also be considered by the AIIMS, representative.

28. It must be mentioned clearly whether bidder is a manufacturer/sole distributor/ sole agent for the items for which he is quoting.

- a. **Manufacturer** must add a certificate that item(s) is manufactured by them as per range of products.
- b. **Sole Manufacturers** must add a certificate that they are the sole manufacturer of the Item for which they are quoting in this tender enquiry & item is /are their proprietary Item in India. The rate certificate is also required from the sole manufactures that the Rates quoted are the same as they quote to other State/Centre Govt./reputed Private organization and DGS&D rate for the similar item(s) and these are not higher than those quoted by them.
- c. **Authorized agents** must add authority letter from their Manufacturer/Principals on the letter head of the manufacturer/principals signed by a competent person and comes in proforma given in attach must duly supported by a notarized affidavit on Indian Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) that they are quoting Rates on behalf of them. The authorization letter must give/mention the purpose for which it is allowed. The validity period of the authorization letter must be mentioned in the authority letter otherwise tender will be liable to rejection.

29. In case the bidder on whom the supply order has been placed, fails to make supplies within the delivery schedule and the purchaser has to resort risk purchase, the purchaser (AIIMS, Bathinda) may recover from the tender the difference between the cost calculated on the basis of risk purchase price and that calculated on the basis of rates quoted by tenderer. In case of repeated failure in supplying the order goods the supply order may be cancelled and bid security deposit will be forfeited.

30. The bidders should have furnished a copy of GST registration number, the State / U.T. of registration and the date of such registration. Tenders not complying with this condition will be rejected.

31. **Turnover provisions:** - (i) The tenderers should submit along with the tender, a photo state copy of the last three years Annual Accounts with Audit certificate by Chartered Accountant, Income Tax returns and a copy of current valid income tax clearance certificate (IT CC), otherwise bidder will not be considered for administrative evaluation (in evaluation of Technical bid) and will be declared **disqualified** in technical evaluation.

- I. In case of bidder falls under Section 44AD/44ADA/44AE of Income Tax shall be required to submit turnover certificate verified by Chartered Accountant with his Registration number issued by Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
- II. In case of supplier is an Indian Agent, the firm can submit copies of purchase orders issued in favour of firm (As the payment is made through LC directly to foreign manufacturer and equipment payment does not exist in the book of account of the supplier) in support to its turnover whatever amount is getting short.

32. Full description & specifications, make/brand and name of the manufacturing firm must be clearly mentioned in the tender, failing which, the tender will not be considered. The tenderer must also mention whether the goods are imported / indigenous. Descriptive literature / catalogues must be attached with the tender in original, failing which, tender may be disqualified.

33. **Force Majeure:** Any failure or omission to carryout of the provisions of this supply by the supplier shall

not give right for any claim by supplier and purchaser to one against the other, if such failure or omission arise from an act of God which shall include all acts of natural calamities from civil strikes compliance with any statistics and or requisitions of the Government lockout and Strikes, riots, embargoes or from any political or other reasons beyond the suppliers control including war (whether declared or not) civil war or state of incarceration provided that notice of the occurrence of any event by either party to the other shall be within two weeks from the date of occurrence of such an event which could be attributed to force majeure. Any delay due to Force Majeure will not be attributable to either of the parties.

34. **Fall Clause:-** If at any time during the execution and currency of this Rate Contract, the Second Party or his manufacturer/Distributor/Dealer reduces the sale price or sells or offers to sell such stores, as are covered under the contract, to any person/organization, including the purchaser or any department of Central Government or any department of AIIMS Bathinda Hospital/PSUs at a price lower than the price chargeable under the contract during the Current Financial Year, the Second Party shall forthwith notify First Party (i.e. Executive Director, AIIMS Bathinda), and the necessary difference amount about such reduction or sale or offer of sale to the purchaser (First Party) and the price payable under the contract for the stores supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction or sale or offer of sale shall stand correspondingly reduced and deposited to First Party by the Bidder or First Party will deduct the difference Amount from the pending bills/Performance Security Deposit to recover the loss to the Government.

35. If there is a close system the tenderer shall ensure and will have to submit an affidavit on Indian Non-Judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- along with technical bid that spare parts and consumables for these equipment's/instruments/item will be available at reasonable fixed rates for next 10 (ten) years, such rates should not be more than the rates supplied to institutes of national importance.

36. The successful Bidder shall at all times agree to indemnify and keep indemnified the purchaser against all losses, damages which may arise in respect of action/inactions of such Bidder or breach of any term of this tender by such Bidder. All claims regarding indemnity shall survive the termination of the contract with such Bidder.

37. In case the vendor fails to supply the spare parts or fails to provide the agreed maintenance during the prescribed period, as per the terms of contract, the purchaser is automatically entitled to procure the required parts and hire services from the market at the risk and cost of the vendor, such inability of bidder will entail forfeiture the security deposit. The purchaser also reserves the right to terminate the contract on immediate notice, if the vendor fails to comply with this clause for more than one instance.

38. **Liquidated damage/demerage:** - The time for the date of delivery/ dispatch stipulated in supply order shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and if the supplier fails to deliver or dispatch any consignment within the period prescribed for such delivery or dispatch in the supply order, liquidated damages may be deducted from the bill @ 0.5% per week subject to maximum of 10% of the value of the delayed goods or services under the contract. The competent authority of the institute may also cancel the supply at the cost & liability of the supplier. In such a case, bid security of the supplier shall stand forfeited. The supply of equipment must be in single consignment, inclusive of all parts & accessories in adherence to the specification so as to make the equipment fully functional at the time of the installation. No installation repeat shall be signed in case of absence of any part as per the specification.

39. **Legal Jurisdiction:** -The Courts at Bathinda alone and no other Court will have the jurisdiction to try the matter, dispute or reference between the parties arising out of this tender/supply Order/contract.

Abnormally Low Bids

40. In case the Bid price of the L-1 bidder, in combination with other elements of the Bid, appears so low that it raises material concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract at the offered price, in such cases, AIIMS may seek written clarifications from the Bidder, including detailed price analyses of the Bid price in relation to scope, schedule, allocation of risks and responsibilities, and any other requirements of the bid document. After evaluating the price analyses, AIIMS may accept/reject the Bid/Proposal. In the case of predatory pricing as well, the above consideration of Abnormally Low Bids (ALB) may be considered.

Applicable Law:

41. The contract shall be governed by the laws and procedures established by Govt. of India, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such Commercial dealings /processing.

42. Any disputes are subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Competent Court and Forum in Bathinda/Chandigarh, Punjab India only.

43. Except as otherwise provided under this Contract for immediate termination of the Contract, in the event

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

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of a disputes which may be arising out of the execution of the tender contract, the matter will be referred to the Deputy Director (Administration). Appeal against the decision of the DDA will lie to the Executive Director, AIIMS Bathinda and his decision shall be final and binding upon both the parties.

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(A) **Financial terms and conditions**

1. Rates are strictly required to be offered/quoted on the prescribed "**Financial Bid format**". Financial bid submitted without prescribed format may not be considered and will be deemed improper subject to the condition that there is a requirement to mention other item which are not mentioned in the said format.
2. Rates quoted should be inclusive of all applicable taxes, packing, forwarding, postage and transportation charges at for AIIMS Bathinda (Site of installation/Use).
3. The supplier has to submit a notarized affidavit on Indian Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.100/- that the bidder has not quoted the price higher than previously supplied to any government Institute/Organization/reputed Private Organization or DGS&D rate in recent past. Therefore, if at any stage it has been found that the supplier has quoted lower rates than those quoted in this tender; the Institute (the purchaser) would be given the benefit of lower rates by the Supplier and any excess payment if any, will become immediately payable to the AIIMS, Bathinda. If such affidavit is not submitted, tender will be out rightly rejected. **(Part of technical bid)**
4. If the price of the contracted articles is/ are controlled by the Government, in no circumstances the payment will be higher than the controlled rate.
5. Tender will be regarded as constituting an offer open to acceptance in whole or in part at the discretion of the competent authority of the institute for a period of 180 days (6 months) valid from the date of opening of the tender by the committee.
6. Order shall be issued for tentative annual requirement on actual need basis. Bills in triplicate for the items supplied by the selected firm(s), should be raised for payment. Payment shall be released after it is ensured that the items/quantity and quality of items supplied are to the entire satisfaction of this office and accepted. If any item is found to be defective, or not of the desired quality, the same shall be replaced immediately, for which no extra payment shall be made by AIIMS, Bathinda.
7. The corrections made by using fluid and overwriting will not be accepted and tender would be rejected.
8. **Tender Currencies:** The bidders are required to quote in Indian Rupees only.
9. **GST:** - If a bidder asks for GST to be paid extra, the rate and nature of tax applicable should be shown separately. The GST will be paid as per the rate at which it is liable to be assessed or has actually been assessed provided the transaction of sale is legally liable to GST and is payable as per the terms of the contract.
10. **Payment terms:** - The payment shall be made to the supplier on satisfactory receipt of the goods ordered. Advance payment shall not be made under any circumstances. The payment shall be made to the supplier's A/C through NEFT/RTGS mode as per the details provided by the supplier.

The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, preparing their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

REGISTRATION

- Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link "Online bidder Enrollment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g., Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.

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GENERAL INTRUCTIONS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

A. PREAMBLE

1. Definitions and Abbreviations

1.1 The following definitions and abbreviations, which have been used in these documents shall have the meanings as indicated below:

1.2. Definitions:

- i. "Purchaser" means the organization i.e. AIIMS/Center/Hospital/Department/Sections purchasing goods as incorporated in the Tender Enquiry Document.
- ii. "Bid" means Quotation / Tender received from a Firm / Tenderer / Bidder.
- iii. "Bidder" means Tenderer/ the Individual or Firm submitting Bids / Quotation/ Tender
- iv. "Supplier" means the individual or the firm supplying the goods as incorporated in the Rate Contract/Purchase Order.
- v. "Goods" means all articles, material, commodity, livestock, furniture, fixtures, raw material, spares, instruments, machinery, equipment, vehicles, medicines, assemblies, sub-assemblies, accessories, intangible products like software, technology transfer, licenses, patents or other intellectual properties purchased or otherwise acquired for the use of Government but excludes books, publications, periodicals, etc. for a library. The term 'goods' also includes works and services which are incidental or consequential to the supply of such goods, such as, transportation, insurance, installation, commissioning, training and maintenance.
- vi. "Services" means services allied and incidental to the supply of goods, such as transportation, installation, commissioning, provision of technical assistance, training, after sales service, maintenance service and other such obligations of the supplier covered under the Rate Contract.
- vii. "Bid Security" (BS) means Earnest Money Deposit / monetary or financial guarantee to be furnished by a bidder along with its tender.
- viii. "Contract" means Rate Contract/Purchase Order which means the written agreement entered into between the purchaser and the supplier, together with all the documents mentioned therein and including all attachments, annexure etc. therein.
- ix. "Performance Security" means monetary or financial guarantee to be furnished by the successful bidder for due performance of the Rate Contract/Purchase Order placed on it. Performance Security is also known as Security Deposit.
- x. "Consignee" means the Center/Hospital/Department/Sections /person to whom the goods are required to be delivered as specified in the Purchase Order.
- xi. "Specification" also called Technical Specifications means the document/standard that prescribes the requirement with which goods has to conform.
- xii. "Inspection" means activities such as measuring, examining, testing, gauging one or more characteristics of the product and comparing the same with the specified requirement mentioned in the Rate Contract/Purchase Order to determine conformity.
- xiii. "Day" means calendar day.

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1.3. Abbreviations:

- I. "ATE" means Advertised Tender Enquiry
- II. "GCC" means General conditions of contract
- III. "SCC" means Special Conditions of Contract
- IV. "DP" means Delivery Period

2. Introduction

2.1 AIIMS, Bathinda is an apex healthcare institutes being established in 2019 by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojna (PMSSY). It is planned with 750-bedded medical institute with 10 specialty, 11 super specialty departments and 16 operation theatres. AIIMS has a trinity of mission, which is medical education, research and patient care. The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Bathinda will catering Drugs/Medicines/I.V. Fluids to all patients. The list of Drugs/Medicines/I.V. Fluids required by AIIMS, is enclosed herewith for your information/reference (enclosed at Annexure-A).

2.2 This tender is for the purpose for executing rate-contract for supply of medicines at whole of the AIIMS, Bathinda

2.3 The Purchaser has issued these Tender Documents for purchase of goods as mentioned in Section – IV – "Schedule of Requirements", which also indicates, *interalia*, the required delivery schedule, terms and place of delivery.

2.4 This section (Section II - "General instructions & conditions of contract") provides the relevant information as well as instructions to assist the prospective bidders in preparation and submission of bids. It also includes the mode and procedure to be adopted by the bidder for receipt and opening as well as scrutiny and evaluation of bids and subsequent placement of Rate Contract/Purchase Order.

2.5 Before formulating the bid and submitting the same to the purchaser, the bidder should read and examine all the terms, conditions, instructions, etc. contained in the Tender Document. Failure to provide and/or comply with the required information, instructions etc. incorporated in these Tender Documents may result in rejection of its Bid.

2.6 The rates quoted, approved and accepted by the Executive Director, AIIMS Bathinda shall be valid for **two years** from the date of signing of the agreement deed (**extendable up-to one year on mutual agreement, if required**).

2.7 Who Can Participate in the Bid?

The tenders are to be submitted by the manufacturers/sole importer only. Tenders quoted by suppliers on behalf of manufacturers will not be entertained even if they are authorized by the manufacturers. However, manufacturers can give authority letter to the supplier / distributor / stockist for the purpose of making supplies, raising bills, collecting payment etc., only after selection in the tender. In such cases, the manufacturer has to accept responsibility for any lapse on

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the part of the distributor/supplier and an undertaking to this effect from the manufacturer will have to be submitted. Failure to submit such an undertaking will lead to rejection of authorization and the manufacturer will have to supply drugs directly. This authorization should be valid for the entire duration of the contract. Changes in the authorized supplier/distributor will be allowed during the rate contract period on the request of OEM only after the approval from the Competent Authority. Different distributors of a manufacturer for different Centers/Hospital will not be allowed. Sub authorization further to any other agent for delivery of the goods or for raising bills/collecting payment etc. will not be accepted. In case the manufacturer authorized the distributor for supply, then direct supply from the manufacturer and raising bills/collecting payment will not be accepted.

Rate Contract

Following three categories of companies/entities will be selected and Rate Contract will be signed with them.

- I. Category 1: Rate Contract 1- the first source for procurement (L-1)
- II. Category 2: Rate Contract 2 - the second (alternative) source for procurement (L-2)
- III. Category 3: Rate Contract 3 - the third (alternative source for procurement (L-3)
- IV. Situation under which supply order might be placed to alternative sources (RC-2 (L-2) AND RC- 3 (L-3), in that order)
 - RC-1 source fails to supply the items within the stipulated time of 30 days.
 - The committee members in their collective judgment are not satisfied with the quality of items procured from RC -1 source.
 - When the RC-1 source fails to honor the terms and condition of the contract e.g. (i) asking for upward revision of prices, (ii) asking for extension of the delivery period beyond the accepted time, (iii) any other request from RC-1 source which does not serve the purpose of the Institute.
 - RC-1 could not perform well on account of good inventory management bringing loss on account of overstocking and expiry to zero level.
 - Whenever RC-1 fails to completely honour three consecutive supply orders the rate contract would be cancelled and RC-2 (L-2) would be made the regular source of procurement and the performance security of RC-1 will be forfeited.
 - In such a situation all clauses related to RC-1 (L-1) shall automatically apply to RC-2 (L-2).
 - Companies' performance during the current Rate Contract will be taken in consideration while finalizing the future tender.

3. Language of Bid

3.1 The bid submitted by the bidder and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged between the bidder and the purchaser, shall be written in the English language. However, the language of any printed literature furnished by the bidder in connection with its bid may be written in any other language provided the same is accompanied by an English translation and, for purposes of interpretation of the bid, the English translation shall prevail.

4. Bid Expense

4.1 The bidder shall bear all costs and expenditure incurred and/or to be incurred by it in connection with its bid including preparation, uploading of its bid and for subsequent processing the same. The purchaser will, in no case be responsible or liable for any such cost, expenditure etc. regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Tender process.

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5. Corrigendum to Tender Enquiry Document

- 5.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the purchaser may, for any reason deemed fit by it, modify the Tender Enquiry Document by issuing suitable Corrigendum to it
- 5.2 Corrigendum will be notified through <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> only.
- 5.3 In order to provide reasonable time to the prospective bidders to take necessary action in preparing their bids as per the amendment, the purchaser may, at its discretion extend the deadline appropriately for the submission of bids and other allied time frames, which are linked with that deadline.

6. Clarification of Tender Enquiry Document

- 6.1 A bidder requiring any clarification or elucidation on any issue of the Tender Enquiry Document may take up the same with the purchaser through CPP Portal only. The purchaser will respond through CPP Portal to such request provided the same is uploaded within the time schedule mentioned in "Critical Date Sheet".

BID OPENING

15. Opening of Bids

- 1.1 E-Bids will be opened after due time and date and the bidders may check the status etc. on CPP Portal.
- 1.2 No change/alteration on plea of clerical or typographical error in rates or other terms in the tender will be permitted under any circumstances.
- 1.3 Withdrawal of the complete tender can be allowed but, in such cases, the earnest money shall be forfeited in full.
- 1.4 Partial withdrawal (in respect of one or more items quoted) will not be allowed under any circumstances.

1.5 PHARMACOPOEIAL SPECIFICATIONS:

Pharmacopoeia' specifications i.e. IP/BP/USP should be clearly mentioned against each drug/constituent of the drug supplied as per the provisions of Drug and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and amendments thereafter and Drug price Control Order.

1.6. Labelling

A. Before making a supply, the approved rate contract holder should ensure that all primary packaging labels (i.e. Ampoules, vials, bottles, jars, tubes etc.) should be embossed, imprinted with a 2-D barcode carrying information about the drug, strength, batch number, date of manufacture, expiry date, place of manufacture, etc. Packing should have labels mentioning "AIIMS-BATHINDA SUPPLY NOT FOR SALE" stamp with permanent ink on each item/strip up to the primary level.

Note: Supply without stamping and with clearly mentioned MRP may be rejected.

B. All items which are stamped with the "AIIMS-BATHINDA SUPPLY NOT FOR SALE" mark, including rejected stores, cannot be sold to the public by the bidder

1.6.1. The supplier shall arrange to effect free replacement of any quantity which may deteriorate potency, strength approaching expiry or expired, etc., before the date of expiry marked on the labels. If the supplier fails to replace the medicines by the expiry date, a penalty of 0.5% per week, subjected

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to a maximum of 10% of the value of expired drugs plus the total value of expired drugs under the contract, will be imposed.

1.6.2. If the supplied item is not utilized before the expiry date, the supplier should undertake to replace it with fresh stock of items with the same or whichever is required.

1.6.3 MARKING: Each packing shall be marked with the nomenclature of the drug and shall be labelled in accordance with the requirements of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the rules made there under.

1.5.4 PACKING :

1. Tendering firms must quote for the packing specified against each item in the schedule annexed to the rate-enquiry, as any other packing may not be accepted.
2. Where no pack is specified, bidders may quote for standard pack which is available in the market.
3. Loose supplies / damaged packing / tampered or damaged labeled supplies shall not be accepted under any circumstances.
4. **Rates should be quoted for one unit** i.e. one tab, one ampoule/vial, one bottle etc.
5. Supplies to be made in the box of Standard packing. However tablets/capsules in loose pack (tin/bottle) shall not be accepted.
6. Liquid orals to be supplied only in glass / plastic bottles.
7. It should be ensured that only first use packaging material of uniform size including bottles and vials, is used for making supplies on the basis of rate- contract.
8. All primary packing containers should be strictly conforming to the specification included in the relevant pharmacopoeia.
9. Packing should be able to prevent damage or deterioration during transit.
10. All containers i.e. bottles, cartons, tubes etc. are required to be secure with pilferage- proof seals to ensure genuineness of the products packed and the correctness of the contents.

1.5.5 The supply offered should comply with the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the Rules made there under as amended up to date and Drug Price Control order.

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SECTION – III

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (SCC)

The following Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) will apply for this purchase. The corresponding clauses of General Conditions of Contract (GCC) relating to the SCC stipulations have also been incorporated below.

These Special Conditions will modify/substitute/supplement the corresponding (GCC) clauses.

Whenever there is any conflict between the provision in the GCC and that in the SCC, the provision contained in the SCC shall prevail.

The warranty conditions, Shelf life, if applicable, will be as mentioned in the Schedule of Requirement as per section IV of the Tender Enquiry Document.

- 1 The quantity shown in the tender can be increased or decreased to any extent depending upon the actual requirement.
- 2 Made misleading or false representation or deliberately suppressed the information in the forms, statements and enclosures required in the eligibility criteria document.
- 3 Any effort on the part of the bidder or his agent to exercise influence or to pressurize the employer would result in rejection of his bid. Canvassing of any kind is prohibited.
- 4 Record of poor performance such as abandoning work, not properly completing the contract, or financial failures / weaknesses, etc.,
- 5 The Originals of the above Certificates shall be produced as and when called for. Irregularities if any observed will lead to rejection of the offer irrespective of the stage at which it is observed. Such bidders will be debarred for bidding in GSO as per applicable rule.
- 6 Firms will be debarred for a period of two years if it is determined that the bidder has breached the code of integrity as per Rule 175 and Rule 151 of GFR 2017.

However, AIIMS reserves the right to get the supplies tested again from a Govt. /NABL accredited laboratory. In case of failure to either supply the goods within DOD (Date of delivery) period or if goods are not accompanied with lab. test report, they may be debarred, after three defaults, from participating in the next tender for a period of three years, and their EMD/Bid Security/Performance Security Money may be forfeited, and the risk purchase clause will be invoked. However, in case of imported drugs, The Delivery period should not exceed 45 days and In house Test Report of the manufacturing Company will be accepted.
- 1.2 Delivery means when the drugs are delivered in the Stores of AIIMS Bathinda
- 1.3 Terms of Delivery
 Goods shall be delivered by the supplier on a "Free Delivery at Site" basis and delivered as per the Delivery Period specified in the Purchase Order placed against the Rate Contract. Please note that time shall be of the essence of the contract. The goods are to be supplied for the destination, and all the transit loss/expenses whatsoever will be borne by the supplier/firm. Goods shall be delivered in working days and working hours, i.e Monday-Friday 9:00 AM to 5 PM and Saturday 9:00 AM to 1 PM.
- 1.4 The purchaser will not pay separately for transit insurance and the contractor will be responsible for delivery of items covered by the supply- order in good condition at the specified destination and for this purpose, freight, insurance, octroi etc., if any will have to be borne by the supplier. The consignee will, as soon as possible, but not later than 20 days of the date of arrival of stores at destination, notify the supplier/ bidder, of any loss or damage to the stores that may have occurred in the transit.

2. Shelf-Life:

- VII. The supplier shall arrange to effect free replacement of any quantity which may deteriorate in potency, strength approaching expiry or expired etc. before the date of expiry marked on the labels.
3. The supply offered should comply with the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the Rules made there under as amended up to date and Drug Price Control order.

For delayed delivery, liquidated damages will get applied as per GCC.

7. Firms which have **US-FDA** approval for export/selling of specified drugs in USA, may submit copies of approval documents from FDA in support of their claim.
8. Manufacturing firms should submit scanned copy of performance certificate(s) of the last three years (2022- 23, 2023-24 & 2024-25) from other similar two Hospital, out of which one must be from Government/Public Sector from the Competent Authority.
